Platinum Pass Guest Information

Arrival by Car

The 'Gold Pass' included with your Platinum Passes is a vehicle pass, which must be affixed to the windscreen of your car. Please enter the Museum by following the signs for 'Gold Passes'. This will give you priority parking on the site. Please then make your way towards the Air Traffic Control tower where the Platinum Pass marquee is situated.

Arrival by Air

Arrivals by air are strictly PPR and must be coordinated with our control tower. Your pilot should contact 01223 833376 to arrange this. The airfield transport will pick you up from your aircraft and drop you at the Platinum Pass Lounge enclosure. Please ensure you inform the driver that you are a hospitality guest.
